Bring on the beef

May is beef month across the United States, and with it comes the beginning of outdoor grilling and summer activities.

Kicking off the Cook-Off

I would like to encourage all National Junior Angus Association (NJAA) members and their parents to start thinking about the 2006 Auxiliary-sponsored All-American Certified Angus Beef® (CAB®) Cook-Off in Indianapolis, Ind., at the National Junior Angus Show (NJAS) in July. The Cook-Off Contest is sponsored by the American Angus Auxiliary and Certified Angus Beef LLC (CAB), and this year marks the 23rd contest.

The Cook-Off competitions include fresh meat, which includes any available cut of CAB; deli meat; and Quick-N-Easy™. In the intermediate division of the fresh meat competition, the winning team members will be awarded the Pat Grote LEAD Award. This scholarship can be used at the upcoming Leaders Engaged in Angus Development (LEAD) Conference hosted by the NJAA. The deli meat competition includes roast beef, corned beef and pastrami. The Quick-N-Easy competition choices include barbecue beef, chili, frankfurters, meatloaf, frozen hamburger patties, pot roast, top sirloin steak and prime rib.

Each state is allowed one team per competition, per age division. The Cook-Off contest is one of the most eventful, educational and competitive activities during the NJAS. The high team overall will be awarded the distinguished Black Kettle

Award in memory of Paul St. Blanc. The Cook-Off is scheduled for Tuesday, July 11, at 1:30 p.m. in the 4-H building.

Anne Patton Schubert, Taylorsville, Ky., and Anne Lampe, Scott City, Kan., coordinate the contest. Entry forms and guidelines can be obtained from Schubert at (502) 477-2663. Recipes and names, addresses and ages of participants need to be received by June 1 for the contest.

Awarding excellence

The Auxiliary will award \$10,000 in scholarships this year to five male and five female winners at the awards program on Friday night during the NJAS. Mary Greiman, Garner, Iowa, scholarship chairman, will award scholarships in the amounts of \$1,200 for first; \$1,050 for second; \$1,000 for third; \$900 for fourth; and \$850 for fifth.

The Auxiliary will also present the Silver Pitcher Awards, which are awarded to one male and one female based on their overall points in the showring. The Janet Castle Crystal Award will be awarded to one male and one female based on their overall placings in the NJAA contests. This award is in memory of Janet Castle, who was one of the founders of the scholarship fund and served as president of the Auxiliary in 1962.

The Pat Grote Belt Buckle Award will be given to the top intermediate division winner in extemporaneous speaking, and the Richard L. Spader Memorial Belt Buckle Award will be given to the top senior extemporaneous speaker.

The Auxiliary will also award the top five contestants in the 2006 National Junior Angus Showmanship Contest Silver Revere Bowls.
